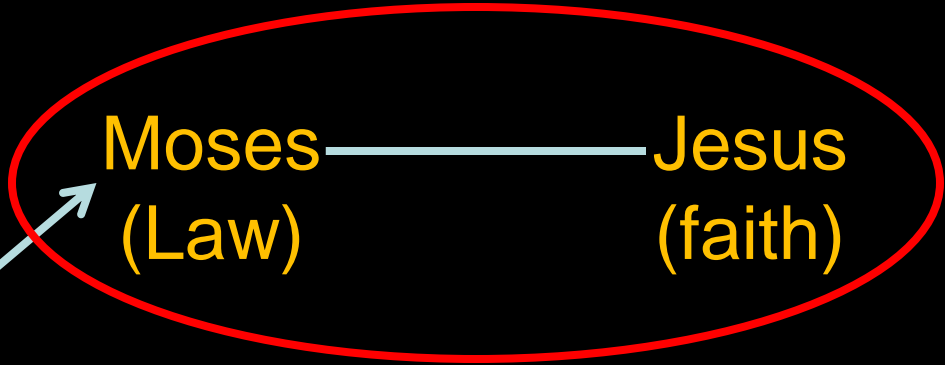
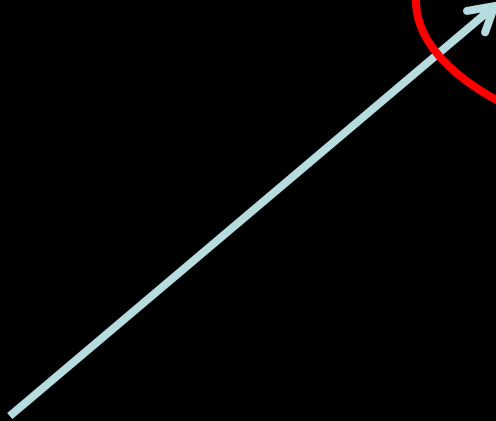


Law + *Faith*

(Law) (faith)

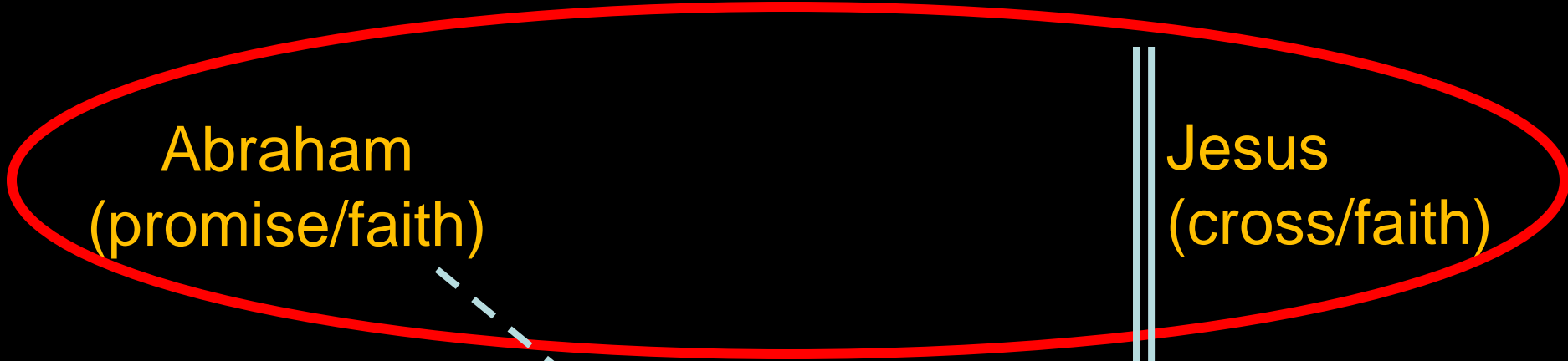
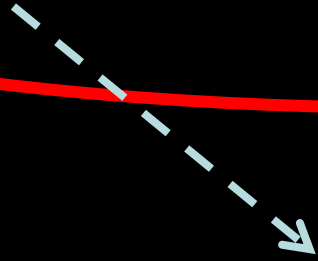
Abraham

The gospel of salvation by faith in Christ is a fulfillment of God's gracious promise to Abraham . How does the Law of Moses (works) relate to the promise to Abraham (faith) in salvation history?

1-The law does not annul God's promise (15-18)

- Because the law came after the promise (15-17)
- Because the law operates on a different principle than the promise (18)

The gospel of salvation by faith in Christ is a fulfillment of God's gracious promise to Abraham . How does the Law of Moses (works) relate to the promise to Abraham (faith) in salvation history?

2-The law does play a role in God's plan (19-22)

- Temporary
- Sin-revealing
- Conditional (based on works, not grace)
- Not for salvation (it is not a rival system)
- Shows the need for salvation

Application:

1. God is sovereign, perfectly working out His purpose in history.
2. We must work to know the story line of the Bible and read the parts of the Bible in their larger context.
3. The law has a necessary function in the proclamation of the gospel.
4. Faithful churches and witnesses will speak about sin.
5. When God confronts you about your sin, His desire is not to destroy you, but to save you.
