2. What does the author say in his worship? Outline the paragraphs!
3. How does this song anticipate the coming of Christ?
4. What modern-day circumstance might compare to that of this psalm?
5. How can I use the pattern of this psalm in my worship?

# 1-His confidence—The LORD's Person (1-3)

- The character of your God
- The limitations of your enemies
- The confidence in your soul

## 2-His Longing –the LORD’s Presence (4-6)

- My singular desire
- My place of protection
- My source of joy

## 3-His Need—The LORD's Protection (7-12)

- God's favor
- God's guidance
- God's deliverance

## 4-His counsel—wait confidently for the LORD (13-14)

- Confidence
- Patience
