

# 1-God's protection is for those who trust in Him (1-2)

## 2-God's protection is genuine (3-13)

- His protection is complete (3-6)
- His protection is personal (7-10)
- His protection is supernatural (11-13)

### 3-God's protection is promised (14-16)

- Who God protects—those in a faith-relationship with Him
- What God promises—deliverance and blessing
